The Certificate III in Education Support will qualify you as a teacher aide, working alongside and supporting teachers in public and independent schools as well as community education. A typical day could include preparing lesson material and assisting children with additional learning needs.

#### CAN I FAST-TRACK THE COURSE?

You can further your qualifications by completing a Certificate IV in Education Support which will enable you to work with special needs students and in a teacher aide role with additional responsibilities including planning, coordinating, overseeing and managing special needs learning programs.
