This Certificate III in Individual Support prepares you for a carer role in hospitals, aged care facilities, respite centres, patient's homes and out in the community. A typical work day includes delivering personalised plans to provide care for the elderly, disabled or disadvantaged.



COURSE LENGTH

One day per week for 19 weeks

CAN I FAST-TRACK THE COURSE?

Yes, we will acknowledge your previous skills and experience and shorten the course if you:

have been working in the industry for more than two years

have previous qualifications issued by other educational institutions that have been completed in full and match the course units.

We can also shorten the course by reducing your work placement if you currently work in the industry, for example, a respite centre, aged care facility or disability service and can provide a letter from your employer stating the role and hours you currently work.

CAN I GET ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS AT THE SAME TIME?

Yes you can! You can complete a dual qualification in Ageing and Community Care for an extra \$250 and 30 hours of work placement.
