Course snapshot

The Certificate IV in Education Support will qualify you as a teacher aide, focusing on special needs students.

You will work alongside and support teachers in special schools as well as children with learning difficulties at public schools, independent schools and through community education.

A typical day could include preparing, coordinating, overseeing and managing lesson material and special needs learning programs, as well as assisting disabled children one-on-one and in group learning situations.



COURSE LENGTH

One day per week for 34 weeks or complete one subject per month online over 17 months

100 hours of work placement
