- Blocked or broken toilets
- Loss of essential amenities (e.g. water, cooking / heating, extended loss of electricity)
- Dangerous electrical faults
- Damage which poses a threat to people's safety and wellbeing
- Lift not working, or any damage / incident which blocks access to or from the property

ARE YOU STORM READY?

Please ensure that any loose items are secure on your balconies or courtyards.

BHC Assets Team works hard to keep our properties storm ready year round by ensuring the gutters and drains in and around the complexes are free of any debris, we also undergo regular garden maintenance to ensure trees are trimmed and loose branches are discarded of appropriately. However, as we are not at all of our complexes every day, if you notice any loose branches or other potential safety risks, before, during or after a storm, please report this your Housing Manager or BHC Reception as soon as possible.



SAVE WATER THIS SUMMER

Currently the combined dam levels in Queensland have fallen below 60% and we encourage everyone to do their bit to save water this summer.

Ways you can save water at home:

- Turn off the tap while you brush your teeth or shave
- Don't continuously run the tap while you wash your dishes
- Cut down on shower times by using a timer
- Keep an eye out for any leaking taps in your unit or any common spaces. If you notice any water leaks big or small, please report this to your Housing Manager or BHC Reception as soon as possible.
